

Snapshot of Progress 2009

Tasmania *Together* is our State's shared vision. It was developed by asking the community how they wanted Tasmania to look in 2020. It contains 12 goals and 151 benchmarks covering social, environmental and economic aspects of Tasmanian life.

Compared to last year ...

INDIVIDUALS & WELLBEING		1. Costs of essentials for low-income families have come down.
		2. There has been no significant change in Tasmanians' feelings of safety at night, both at home and in public places. However, the 2020 target for feeling safe in public places at night has been achieved.
		3. There has been no significant change in the proportion of Year 5 students achieving the national standard in reading compared with Australia.
		4. There has been a reduction in the number of avoidable deaths (2007 data).
COMMUNITY		5. Regional population levels were maintained (2008 data).
		6. Attendance at cultural heritage sites including our museums and art galleries has increased.
		7. The number of visitor centres with Aboriginal cultural interpretation has not increased.
		8. The percentage of people voting in local government elections declined slightly.
ECONOMY		9. There are fewer people participating in the workforce.
		10. Tasmania has had strong investment growth.
ENVIRONMENT		11. The amount of land protected in conservation reserves has increased.
		12. Tasmania's greenhouse gas emissions increased (2007 data).
